DAY 01 / OCT 08

DAY 02 / OCT 09

ARRIVE ISTANBUL / IZNIK 'NICEA' / BURSA

(L/D)

Welcome to Istanbul. Drive to Nicea for Iznik Hagia Sophia, the venue of the 7th Ecumenical Council in 787 AD restoring the veneration of holy images after it was suppressed by the Byzantine Emperor Constantine V. Visit Cumalikizik Village, one of the finest examples of Ottoman architecture. Continue to the "UNESCO World Heritage Listed" city of Bursa. Visit the Grand Mosque, the 5th most important mosque after those in Mecca, Medina, Jerusalem and Damascus. There are plenty of things to do as you stroll around the 700 - year old Ottoman Village. Admire the narrow, cobblestoned streets – try to picture it during the old times. Try some local delicacies like baklava, sarma or blackberry juice. Shop for some souvenirs or pose for a photo in an Ottoman attire. Such an authentic experience!

DAY 03 / OCT 10 BURSA / PERGAMUM / THYATIRA / SMYRNA / IZMIR / KUSADASI (B/L/D)

Travel to the plains and foothills along the Caicus River for the **Pergamum Red Basilica**, (Rev.2:12-17) one of the largest surviving Roman structures from the ancient Greek world. Go up to the **Acropolis Ancient City** via cable car for an amazing view of the city of Pergamum. Next is the ancient city of **Thyatira** (Rev 2:18-29) known for its textiles and dyeing trade. Continue to **Smyrna** (Rev 2:8-11), today known as Izmir, the third largest Turkish city housing the second busiest port in the country. Finish the day in Kusadasi.

DAY 04 / OCT 11 KUSADASI / EPHESUS / KUSADASI (B/L/D)

Take a day trip to this "UNESCO World Heritage site" - ancient city of Ephesus another church of revelation. Visit the **House of Virgin Mary** where it is believed that Mother Mary spent the last of her days. Pope John Paul II declared this place as a Pilgrimage Place for Christians. It is believed that the Evangelist St. John spent his last years in **Ephesus**. Three hundred years after his death, a small chapel was constructed over his grave and over the years it was converted and now known as the **Basilica of St. John**. See ancient **Library of Celsus**, a distinctive landmark considered one of the most beautiful surviving structures of the Roman times. See the remains of the ancient **Temple of Artemis**, one of the "Seven wonders of the world."

Stop at a leather jacket factory along the way. See how elegant and beautiful these jackets are, you surely would want to own one!

DAY 05 / OCT 12

KUSADASI / SARDIS / PHILADELPHIA / LAODICEA / PAMUKKALE (B/L/D)

Another church of revelation, the city of **Sardis** (Rev. 3:1-6), now housing popular ruins of decadent temples and bath house complexes. Next is **Philadelphia** (Rev 3:7-13) the city is now famous for its temples and worship centers. Drive to **Laodicea** (Rev.3:14-22) along the Lycus River Valley of western Asia Minor.

Visit Pamukkale – literally means "cotton castle." See two of the fantastic sights in this town. First, the remains of the ancient Roman City of Hieropolis with its beautiful amphitheater and multiple temples. Next, is the *UNESCO World Heritage* Cotton Castle, a limestone terraces filled with crystal blue waters – truly Instagram worthy! Be sure you are dressed up for your photo ops!

Tonight, you may opt to take a dip at thermal pools in your hotel to relax and soothe your tired muscles.

DAY 06 / OCT 13

PAMUKKALE / KONYA / CAPPADOCIA (B/L/D)

Visit an "ancient caravanserai," a roadside inn where travelers' from across the globe would stay after a day of trade and commerce during the ancient times. Set foot at Antioch of Pisidia "Yalvac", the town which St. Paul visited on his first missionary journey. See the city's artifacts at the Yalvac Museum.

DAY 07 / OCT 14 CAPPADOCIA

(B/L/D)

Early morning **OPTIONAL TOUR** activity: Never leave Cappadocia without experiencing their famous **Hot Air Balloon Ride**. In the first light of the rising sun, take off with hundreds of balloons and see the first rays of sunlight turn the valleys and rock formations into gold – magical and one for the books!!!

Tour around the magical city of Cappadocia. Admire the whimsical rock formations and valleys with beautiful peaks in different colors surrounding the city. See the "fairy chimney rock formations" at the Pigeon Valley. Click and snap photos with the nice view of the fairy land Uchisar Castle Village. Walk into the Goreme Open Air Museum with the most beautiful Byzantine frescoes that has been well preserved for many years. Finally, to an Underground city, an impressive underground dwelling that once served as a refuge for many Christians during the 14th century from the invasion of Mongolians and in the 20th century to escape persecution during the Ottoman Empire. In between the tour, you will be given a Turkish Carpet weaving course. Stop by a Turquoise and Onyx handmade store. See local people craft their hand made potteries in a Pottery Village and Art Center.
